The Effect of Authoritarian Parenting Style in Subjects of Domestic Violence. (Dra. Fransiska I. R. Dewi, M. Si.). Bachelor Degree of Psychology, Tarumanagara University. (107 pages, P1-P4, L1-L14).

Parenting style is a realization of parents and children interaction while doing the caring activity. Parenting style in family also determines someone behaviour, include the violence behaviours. In authoritarian parenting style, parents have competence to punish and do the violence to their children if the children do some falses or break the parents rules. Like a part of learning process, children will learn the violence behaviours as a method to solve any problems in family. The family styles or habits which always use the violence as a method to solve problems, can lead someone to behave violence when they are adult, include when they have family. The aim of this research is to find out the effect of authoritarian parenting style in subjects of domestic violence. Domestic violence is the violence which is pointed to the family members in home. In usual, domestic violence is done by husband to his wife and children. Data collecting is done with deep interview to the subjects of domestic violence in April 2008 until May 2008. The results of interview to the four subjects show that the authoritarian parenting style has effect in domestic violence subjects. The subjects experience in which always got the violence from their parents in their past effect them when they married. When subjects face some problems with their wife or when their children do some falses, they will do the violence to their wife and children.
