

## **ABSTRACT**

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**Conflict in Interpersonal Relationship among Young Adulthood Women who Work in Public Accounting Firm. (Henny E. Wirawan M. Hum., Psi.). Undergraduate Program in Psychology Tarumanagara University. (89 Pages, R1-R3, Appdx 1-Appdx 9).**

Conflict is one condition when two parties, individuals or groups have disagreement, different goals, or perception that occurs in interpersonal relationship. Conflict can be caused by different set of value, difference of personality characteristic, and failure of communication. Conflict may arise to everyone, include the women in young adulthood who enter the career period or focusing to the family.
