Proposition in the sub head should ne miniscule.

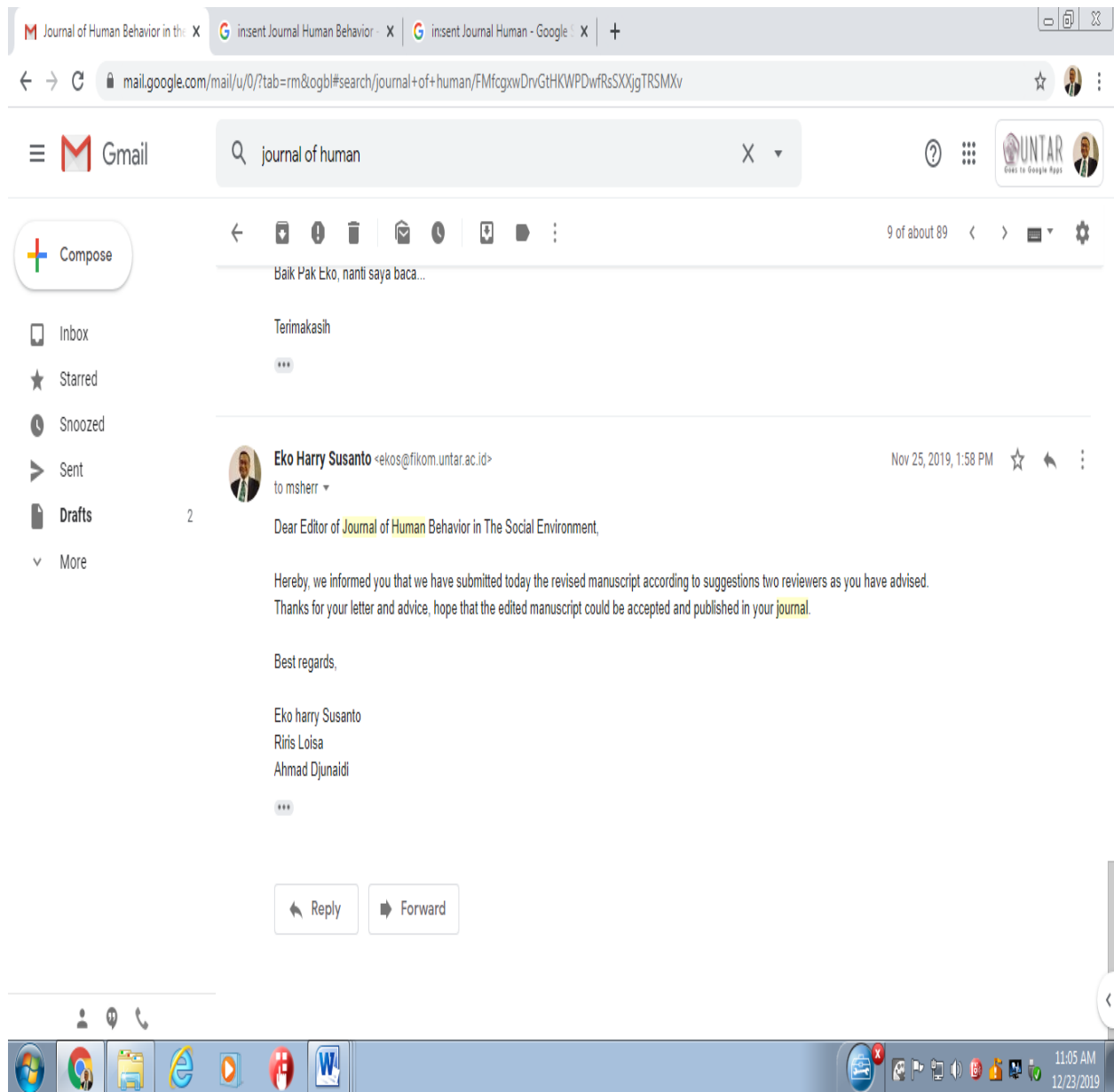
