Correlation between Religiosity and Conversion Motives for Adulthood who has Conversion Religion. (Yohannes Budiarto, S.Pd., M.Si.). Undergraduate Program, Faculty of Psychology, Tarumanagara University (75 pages, P1-P2, L1-L30)

The objective of this research is to identify the correlation between religiosity and conversion motives for adulthood who has conversion religion. This research encloses 41 participants in Jabodetabek, especially in Jakarta and Tangerang by *snowball sampling*. According to Pearson Correlation, there is positif and significant correlation between religiosity (*faith based coping* and *religious social support / activity*) and intelektual also mystical motives. There is negative and significant correlation between religiosity (*faith based coping*) and experimental, revivalist, and coercive motives. Also, there is negative and significant correlation between religiosity (*faith based coping*) and experimental and coercive motives. There is no evidence that there is a relation between religiosity and affective motives.
